#### **Preface**

This compilation of quotations started off as a web site I developed in January 2004. This site intended to create a database of quotes along the lines of "It's not what you know, it's who you know."

Quotations were submitted by several users at Carshalton Boys Sports College, with over 200 of them added fairly quickly. Quotations, in the book, are sorted by the user that submitted them.

The Quote Site and this book, were inspired by John Bourke, who unwittingly named the web site: whoyouknow.co.uk. This name came from the repeated quotation: it's not what you know, it's who you know.

The site started off as a joke, but soon became a database of many quotations and also my A2 ICT project.

Thanks to John Bourke for the quotations he has inspired us with, throughout the Sixth Form.

A special thanks to Kyle Halsey and Sagar Patel, for the large number of quotes that they added; and for their initial idea for the web site. Kyle should be known as the quote master, for the sheer amount of quotes he has submitted.

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### **Prologue**

It all started on January 15<sup>th</sup> 2004, with the purchase of whoyouknow.co.uk. It was something that Kyle Halsey said, that prompted me to buy the domain. I can't remember exactly what – something to do with it's not what you know..., no doubt – but the next day, I told Kyle about the domain; he also wanted it. Too late, Kyle!

So, I had the domain. What to do with it!? This is where Kyle comes back into the picture, closely followed by Sagar Patel. It was by suggestion of these two, that I create a quotes database. The idea was to add quotes that Mr Bourke would say, or at least ones that sounded like something he would quote.

Well, I now had the domain and the idea. At the time I had very little knowledge of HTML, let alone the required database and scripting. I decided to teach myself HTML, PHP and MySQL, which may seem like a lot, but they all link together making it easier to learn together.

I started out with some simple tutorials, and during some ICT lessons (I though I might as well add some computing to the ICT course!), I wrote my first PHP pages. My first page being one that said 'Test'. Shortly after these few pages, I began to create database driven pages, which displayed the words 'test', 'test2', 'test3' taken from a database.

The first implementation of a quote database was a plain web site that displayed the quotes entered by the user at the bottom of the page. It soon became apparent that login identification was necessary, as Mr Bourke would not have liked some of the quotes that appeared.

Within a month the site was fully working. Users had to now sign up, in order to add quotes. Quotes also had to be approved by me, before being displayed.

Quotes were added to the site by several users at CBSC, Kyle being the person who added the most.

This was, of course, all done with out the knowledge of Mr Bourke, as the site was predominantly used for joke 'Bourke-like' quotes. Well it stayed that way for all of about a month. This was when Sagar thought it would be funny to sign Mr Bourke up to the site. An email was immediately sent, which informed the new user of their signing up to site.

The next morning I saw Mr Bourke, he said 'What is the email that you sent me?' – The email had 'from James Hamilton', at the bottom! I quickly explained that Sagar thought it would be funny to sign him up. He was in a hurry.

A little later, he again confronted me. This time I explained that the site was a database of quotes. An immediate reaction followed: "Oh, I have got some great quotes."

Oh, the irony! I couldn't stop laughing, when he left the room. There we were, creating a joke web site, aimed at Mr Bourke, when he joins in.

After that came along my design for a whoyouknow.co.uk business card, with a little help from Ken Bailey. He designed the site's logo.

Shortly after a T-Shirt followed. The words: "It's not what you know...", where printed on the front and "It's who you know" printed on the back.

And then came this book...

#### **Foreword**
